Rationale: At a time when the Common Core assessments require that our students read

Challenging and grade appropriate materials, we need to provide extra support and Remediation for students who are reading below grade level.

Benefits: Students enrolled in the course will receive direct and targeted reading instruction aimed at bringing them up to a grade level. This will improve their chances for achieving competency across the curriculum since the ability to read well impacts all courses.
