We also had students vote to their favorite books: The winners are: *Hunger Games*, *Mockingjay*, *Twilight*.

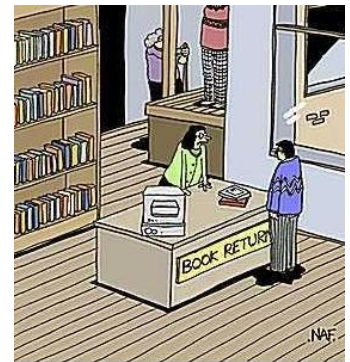
### Return Books

We do not charge for

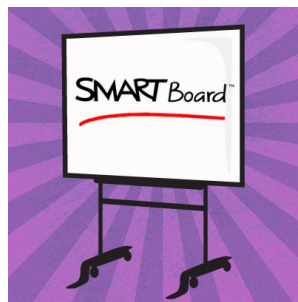
overdue books, but books not returned must be paid for by the end of the year. You will on the fines list for the charge of the book if it is not returned.
