

CONCURRENT FAQ's for FALL 2020

Concurrent Enrollment Guidelines for the 2020-21 school year

Student electing to take a concurrent enrollment class must adhere to the deadlines set forth by Salt Lake Community College:

*Admissions, Test Scores and Small Balance Holds – September 4, 2020

*Registration and Drop deadline – September 11, 2020

*Withdrawal deadline – September 18, 2020

If your concurrent class falls on a "B Day" you are still required to meet the deadlines listed above.

Students choosing a concurrent English or Math class (ENGL 1010, ENGL 2010, MATH 1030, MATH 1050) must contact Kim Powell or Anne Martin by **August 7, 2020** to verify you have met the requirements for those classes:

*Admission to Salt Lake Community College

*Qualifying test scores on file at SLCC

*Instructions on how to set up your MyPage at SLCC to register for the class

The Concurrent Enrollment application (\$40.00) and partial tuition (\$5.00 per credit hour) fees are not covered by fee waivers.

Students can apply for the CE Scholarship Program to help with the cost of those fees.
