 <u>Non-Resident Tuition Waivers</u> | Admissions (utah.edu)
 - The Utah State Legislature passed House Bill 144 in 2002 which allows eligible Utah high school graduates the opportunity to attend Utah universities & colleges & have the non-resident portion of their tuition waived. A student can qualify for this waiver if they:
 - o Attended a Utah high school for three or more years
 - Graduated or will graduate from a Utah high school or attained the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED) in Utah
 - Have not registered for college classes prior to the Fall 2002 academic school year.
 - o Don not hold a current visa
 - Have filed or will file an application to legalize their immigration status as soon as they are eligible to do so
- Non-Resident Students: Utah Senate Bill 253
 - As of May 12, 2015, Utah SB 253 makes it so any student who graduates from a Utah high school (regardless of high school graduation year) IS NOT required to provide proof of lawful US presence for scholarships or tuition waivers in Utah's public colleges & universities. Therefore, regardless if the student has or does not have DACA, as long as they have graduated from a Utah high school, they may apply to privately funded scholarships administered by a Utah public colleges or university!

- Non-Resident Students: Utah House Bill 118
 Non- Resident Tuition Waivers | Admissions (utah.edu)
 - The House Bill 118 tuition waiver allows eligible Utah high school graduates the opportunity to attend Utah universities and colleges and have the non-resident portion of their tuition waived. A student can qualify for this waiver if they:
 - Are a foreign national legally admitted to the US (holds a non-immigrant visa such as F-1, H-4, J-1, etc.)
 - Attended a Utah high school for three or more years.
 - Graduated or will graduate from a Utah high school or attained the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED) in Utah.

Required documents for House Bill 118 tuition waiver:

 - o Complete FAFSA by January 20

UTAH STATE - Utah State Promise (Available at all USU campuses)

The Utah State Promise is a "last dollar" scholarship, meaning it is applied to your remaining tuition & student body fees after all other aid is applied. What is considered other aid & what order is it applied? First, Federal Pell Grant (FAFSA), and then second, USU will apply other scholarships (e.g., institutional awards, department, Regents, outside/3rd party). After all aid & scholarships are applied, USU pays any remaining balance due.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Submit FAFSA & be Pell Grant Eligible
- Utah resident, US citizen, or eligible non-citizen
- Be admitted as first-time incoming undergraduate
- Intend to graduate from USU
- Renewal for up to 4 years (must remain pell eligible, good standing-academics, up to full tuition & student body fees)

SOUTHERN UTAH UNIVERSITY - SUU - Access Utah Promise Scholarship

CRITERIA:

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Have not received an associate degree or higher postsecondary degree
- Be a resident of Utah
- Must demonstrate financial need
- Accept all other grants, tuition/fee waivers, & scholarships offered to the applicant
- Maintain and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress

A RECIPIENT MAY RECEIVE SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS UNTIL ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OCCURS:

- Two years after the initial award
- A recipient uses the scholarship for four semesters
- A recipient meets the academic qualifications for an associate degree
- Or earns a cumulative total of 60 credits
- Recipients must submit FAFSA each year
 - o Do verifications if needed

DIXIE STATE UNIVERSITY – TRAILBLAZER PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

The Utah Promise Scholarship is the first-ever statewide needs-based scholarship program in Utah. It is available to recent high school graduates & adult learners at Utah's public colleges & universities, as well as Utah's public technical colleges. The Utah Promise Scholarship will cover up to tuition & fees for up to two years. The Trailblazer Promise is automatically awarded at DSU through a completed FAFSA Application to those who qualify. This process happens after the 3rd week of each semester. If you are awarded the Trailblazer Promise, you will receive an email from the Financial Aid Office to your Dmail account. There is no separate application required except a completed FAFSA Application.

WESTMINSTER – THE WESTMINSTER COMMITMENT

The tuition-free program is for academically driven students from Utah who have financial need.

Criteria:

- Submit an admissions application by the college's Feb. 1 regular decision deadline
- Be admitted to Westminster College
- Submit a FAFSA
- Have a total family income below \$60,000 and limited assets*
- Have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.3 (at the time of decision)
- Graduate from a Utah high school
- Enroll as a first-time, full-time undergraduate student in Fall 2022

Amount: Covers tuition costs for eligible students for 4 years after all other federal, state, and Westminster aid is applied to a student's account. Does not cover room & board costs.

UTAH VALLEY UNIVERSITY - UVU - Greenlight Scholarship

Greenlight Scholarship | Financial Aid | Utah Valley University (uvu.edu)

This scholarship fills the gap to cover tuition for students who receive the Pell Grant (FAFSA) but may still owe additional tuition. For students who qualify, the cost of a two-year degree will be covered by federal aid and UVU. Your first two years are covered!

- Eligibility
 - o Complete the FAFSA and receive a Pell Grant each year
 - o Be a Utah Resident
 - o Enrolled on a full-time basis (at least 12 credits)
 - o Priority given to first-year and second-year students admitted with a complete financial aid file by May 15
 - Must have attempted fewer than 60 credit hours
- How to apply
 - o Be admitted to UVU
 - Complete the FAFSA & be awarded a Pell Grant by May 15 (to receive first priority)
 - o No scholarship application is required. UVU will award the scholarships automatically
- Example:
 - o UVU tuition per semester \$2,561
 - o Student receives Pell Grant for \$1,000
 - o Difference: \$1,561
 - UVU provides a scholarship for \$1,561 Tuition Balance = \$0

SALT LAKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE -- SLCC Promise: helps eligible students pay for their education by covering the cost of tuition & fees when federal grants fall short.

SLCC Promise | SLCC

- Who's Eligible
 - Utah Resident
 - o Receive a Federal Pell Grant
 - o Take 9 or more credits in Fall & Spring semester or take 6 or more during summer
 - o All SLCC students are encouraged to meet with an academic advisor
 - o Maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA & complete 70% of attempted courses.

WEBER STATE UNIVERSITY -- DREAM WEBER --

Information: Dream Weber

Application: Central Authentication Service (weber.edu)

The Dream Weber program provides free tuition & general student fees to students enrolled in 12 semester credits, who qualify for a Pell Grant & whose annual household income is \$40,000 or less. The amount awarded varies depending on each applicants FAFSA, as the Dream Weber program supplements any other aid that is awarded.

How to Follow Your Dream (Weber)

- 1. Apply for admissions
- 2. Starting Sept. 1, apply for Dream Weber scholarship
- 3. Complete FAFSA
- 4. Check your email

Eligibility:

- Be a legal Utah resident
- Have a household income of \$40,000 or less
- Qualify for FAFSA federal Pell Grant funds
- Be an undergraduate student with less than 150 credit hours

Maintaining Your Scholarship (reapply each year):

- Enroll & maintain a course load of 12-18 credit hours/semester
- Attain satisfactory academic standing & maintain a 2.0 GPA
- Qualify for Federal Pell Grant funds
 - Apply each year for federal funds FAFSA
 - o Complete WSU scholarship application

Conditions:

- Dream Weber covers the cost of full-time tuition (between 12-18 credit hours) & general student fees
- Eligibility continues for a total of 8 semesters or until you reach 150 semester hours

- Advanced Course Track:
 - Earn a 3.3 Cumulative HS GPA
 - Complete 3 advanced courses
 - Complete 1 AP, IB or Concurrent course in each of the core areas of HS graduation:
 - Math
 - Science
 - Language Arts
 - Complete FAFSA
 - Graduate from HS
- Regents Track (class of 2022 ONLY):
 - Same Regents requirements from year's past
- Both tracks lead to the same scholarship. There is no difference in award amount based on which track students complete
- Completing a FAFSA is required as part of the application process, but FEDERAL AID is NOT considered when determining eligibility
- Unlike Regents, the Advanced Course track allows students to grant USHE permission to pull their transcripts and class records electronically. No more
 submitting hard copies of transcripts.
- If a student qualifies and can apply for either track, USHE recommends they apply for the Advanced Course track. It is much easier.
- Scholarship can be used at the following institutions: Dixie, SLCC, Snow, SUU, USU, UVU, UofU, Weber, BYU, Ensign, Westminster, Western Governors University
- Can be deferred!!
