


ROOM D304 CLASS PROCEDURES

- 5. Respect yourself, your classmates and your teacher. (No profanity. EVER)




Expectations

LATE / INCOMPLETE WORK

- My expectation is that **ALL** assignments be completed to the best of the student's ability and turned in on time to earn full credit. Weekly Folders (LA) turned in within 24 hours earn 90%, after that 50% for one week then zero.
- Use class time productively: any work not completed becomes homework.
- Class work assignments accepted late at my discretion for partial grade.
- Saying "But I didn't understand" is not an excuse for late work or not turning in work. Make sure you do!
- Printer and Internet issues are not an excuse for late work.

ABSENTEE POLICY



YES, WE DID SOMETHING IMPORTANT WHILE YOU WERE ABSENT. It is the student's responsibility to check with your study buddy, Edmodo, or arrive early to see me before class.

Because most work is assigned ahead of time on Edmodo, you are not given extra time to make this up unless there are special circumstances, which need to be discussed with me.

PARTICIPATION POINTS: You have one free pass per quarter for an excused absence. All other absences (excused and excused) require seat time to be made up – see me about this. Points lost for misbehavior and being late or tardy cannot be made up.
